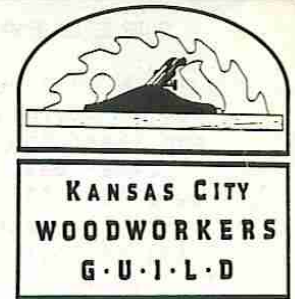

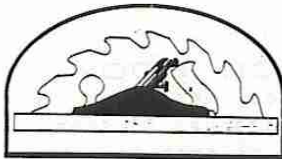
TREASURY REPORT
